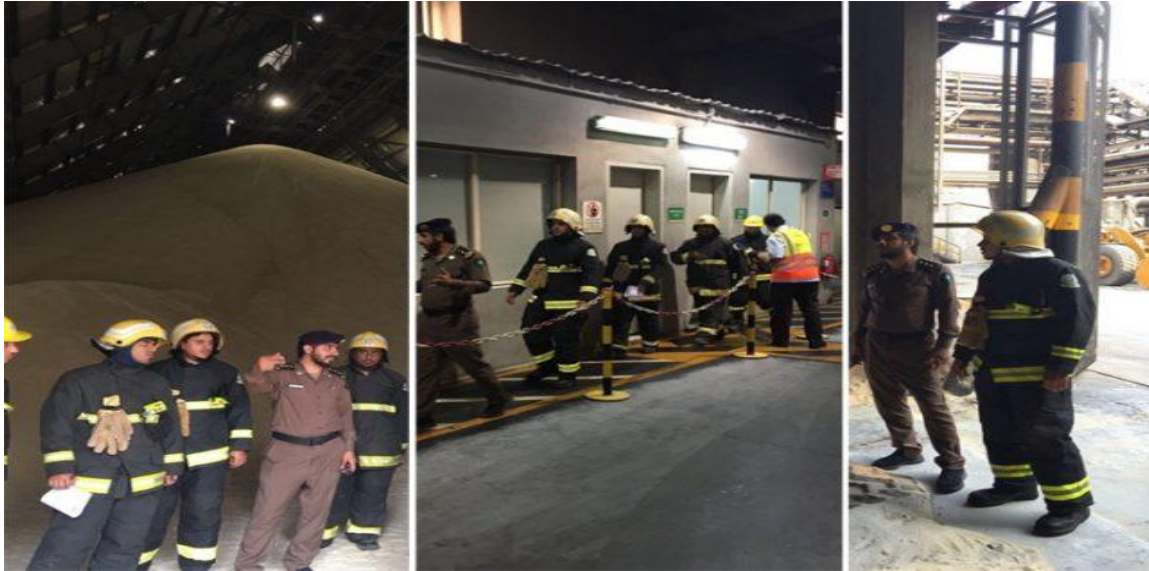


Civil Defense team visits United Sugar Company factory
